In keeping with the custom and observing the primary purpose of Annual reporting, may I now present you parents & my dear school community, our school activities & achievements throughout the year 2017-2018 highlighting the significant events.

To equip our teachers to excel, many faculty improvement programmes were held. Teachers attended 3 days orientation class at Bangalore by the Christ University.

One week English orientation class was given to enhance their communication skill at Kowdiar Christ Nagar School.

Teachers participated in the workshops conducted by Sahodaya in various streams.

Time to Time staff meeting were held to discuss and motivate the teaching skill.

While we are living in the present, we must celebrate life everyday, knowing that we are becoming history with every work, every action, every deed....

1. **Re-opening Day Celebration** of our school conducted on 23.06.2017. Christ Nagar Central School took over the charge of K E Carmel Central School in May 2017. Very Rev Fr Sebastian Chamathara CMI, the provincial was the chief guest. His happiness and support was very evident and we were amazed when He sang “How great thou Art.....”
2. **Investiture ceremony** was celebrated on 07/07/2017 Mr Mohanakumar (Additional sub inspector of police, Kattakada was the chief guest. Master Akshay Vinod, Kumari Surya S Nair were selected as Head boy & Head Girl along with student council ; in the Glittering function and badges and sashes were distributed to them.

3. Awareness to the students about various days, we have conducted

- a. Postal Day was celebrated by taking the students to the post office of our locality. Students greeted the staff of Ottasekharamangalam Post office. The staff introduced the ways of communication to children.
- b. Anti - Corruption Day – In connection with anticorruption day, students visited Police Station, Electricity Office and Taluk Office along with Teachers.
- c. International Girls Day was celebrated on October 11. The Principal, Dr Shiny Mathew inaugurated the programme. The school head boy took a pledge along with all the boys that they will respect girls and walk in the path of justice and truth. A special musical performance by boys for girls was the most attractive event of the celebration.
- d. World sight day was observed on October 12th. Mr 'Francis', teacher & a visually challenged person from Govt High school, Plavoor was honoured. He was adorned Golden thread by the school Principal Dr Shiny Mathew. Children were blind folded themselves to dedicate a few minutes to those who are visually challenged and shared their experiences, while they were blind folded.
- e. International Egg day was observed on 13th October. In connection with it we made an awareness to the children about importance of eggs. Teachers prepared different varieties of dishes made of eggs and distributed to students.
- f. Book Lovers Day. We should always consider the values of others. Our children brought books with an aim to open a

small library in our locality to develop the reading habit and enjoy leisure time named 'Aksharathangu'

- g. Maths Day – To give awareness to the students about the 'day to day dealings' of maths and to have feeling of fun in mathematics Children and teachers made the day to be named as 'fun maths'
- h. Founders Day Rev Fr Chavara Kuriakose Elias, the founder of CMI is a great visionary in the field of education. To remember his great executions 'A Handful rice programme, Pidi ari' was conducted. Students together brought 275 kg rice and distributed to 50 families who are financially backward in the society. Also visited the houses of the victims Okhi at Vettukadu and distributed basic necessary items.
